Hiawathaland Transit is a public transit, curb-to-curb bus service operated by Three Rivers Community Action, Inc. and is available to anyone for any reason. Riders of all ages use our Dial-A-Ride bus service to go to places such as work, school, grocery store, doctors office, the pharmacy, or friendly visits and many more locations! Our buses can transport you anywhere within the set service area of each community.

Our Dispatchers are trained to handle all of your transportation needs and place you with the service that best meets your individual needs.

For your *Information*

All of our Hiawathaland Transit vehicles are handicap accessible. When scheduling your ride, please inform the dispatcher if you would like to use the "lift" to board.

We ask that you be ready and waiting 15 minutes in advance of your scheduled time and know the bus may run up to 15 minutes past your scheduled time. Once our bus arrives at your stop, it will wait for 1-minute before departing.
